Green Beans with Feta Cheese and Dill

<p>2 pounds fresh green beans, trimmed</p> <p>¼ cup low fat Italian dressing</p> <p>¼ cup traditional Feta cheese</p>	<p>¼ cup chopped red onion</p> <p>¼ cup chopped fresh dill</p> <p>¼ cup almonds</p> <p>1 teaspoon lemon juice</p>

Steam green beans in a small amount of water for 5 minutes or until tender.

Rinse with cold water. Drain.

Place the cooked green beans in a large bowl and add the remaining ingredients.
