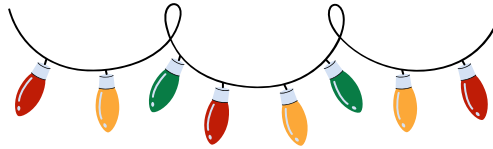

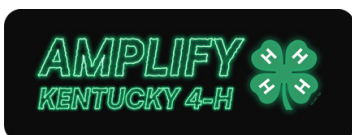

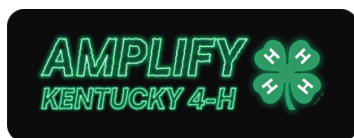

Recipe of the Month



Glazed Butternut Squash with Carrots and Turnips

1½ cups cubed butternut squash	½ teaspoon salt
1½ cups sliced carrots	¼ teaspoon pepper
1½ cups cubed peeled turnips	Cooking spray
4 teaspoons oil	2 tablespoons maple syrup

1. Preheat oven to 450 degrees.
2. Cut vegetables into ½-inch pieces.
3. Coat a 9 x 13-inch baking dish with cooking spray.
4. Combine the first 6 ingredients.

5. Bake for 10 minutes.
6. Stir in syrup and bake an additional 20 minutes.

Yield: 8, ½ cup servings.

Nutritional Analysis: 60 calories, 2.5 g fat, 0g sat fat, 1 g protein, 9 g carbohydrate, 0 mg cholesterol, 170 mg sodium, 2 g fiber.
