Melon Berry Smoothie

| 1/4 cup skim milk | 1 cup frozen blueberries, strawberries or mixed berries |
| 1 cup low fat vanilla Greek yogurt | 1 tablespoon honey, optional |
| 2 cups chopped honey dew melon | |

Place all ingredients in blender. **Blend** together until smooth using the pulse function, if available. **Pour** into serving glasses and serve immediately.

Yield: 4, 8 ounce servings.
